





### GdB position: the good, the bad and the ugly

### The good

- Greening is here to stay
- More focus on farmers (and other stakeholders) working together
- Opportunities to connect research with practice
- First step in integration with other policy domains

### The bad

- Still no public money for public goods
- No real incentives for frontrunners
- More complex instead of simpler
- Not more money for rural development

### The ugly:

- Lack of sense of urgency
- Traditional forces still in power
- Greening could be counter-productive
- TTIP could change everything
- In 2020: we lost 7 years
